Come, witness creativity!

Historic Artists' Homes and Studios (HAHS), a program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation, is a national network of 55 sites that were the homes and studios of American artists – now all open to the public. Collectively, the consortium aims to preserve the nation's legacy in the visual arts and inspire meaningful experiences at authentic creative places.

The artists associated with these properties represent the historical evolution of art in this country, spanning over three centuries, and include an inspiring variety of representation in painting, sculpture, graphic arts, photography, furniture, and decorative arts. These extraordinary sites introduce more than one million visitors annually to the living and workspaces of artists across 25 states in the nation.

Looking around the studio environment and the home of the artist, you can discover a specific, demonstrable relationship between an artist, his or her art, and their surroundings. These spaces were catalysts for creativity, and today visitors experience the environment where this creativity was nurtured.




